Your five-point checklist following an accident

1. Stay calm, ensure everyone is safe and don't admit fault.
2. Call **999** for an ambulance if anyone is injured. Call the police on **101** (the non-emergency number) if the other driver leaves without giving details.
3. Make a note of the other driver's details and any witnesses by filling out the form overleaf. If possible, take pictures of the cars, drivers, passengers, damage and the accident scene from several angles.
4. Report the incident to RSA Motability (RSAM) on **0300 037 3737** as soon as possible. Lines are open 8am to 8pm Monday to Friday, 8am to 4pm Saturday. (If it is outside of these hours, make sure you report the incident when the lines are next open.)
5. If you are unable to drive your car, call the RAC on **0800 73 111 73** or **0333 202 1878** for roadside support and assistance. They are available to help 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. If you are in the Republic of Ireland, the number to call is **1800 535 005**.
